

**Desktop Context Menu Customizer** is a [portable](#) application to add frequently-used application's shortcuts as well as Windows native utilities and Control Panel applets to Windows right-click [context menu](#) , so that you can quickly open them without having to manually navigate through different locations. It lets you add items to both normal view and extended view (accessible via Shift+right-click) of the context menu. Furthermore, you have the option to create and edit cascading context menus, add specific items to either desktop right-click menu or Windows Explorer right-click menu and change the positions of items in context menus.

To begin, launch the application and head over to *Desktop Default Single Menu* tab to add applications' shortcuts to context menu. From

*Add Program*

tab, specify the application source path and select its

*Position*

in context menu. Now, give it an appropriate name and hit Apply Changes to add item to context menu. You can add as many application's shortcuts to context menu as you want in similar

fashion. to If you check

*Extended Menu*

option, the item will be added to the extended context menu

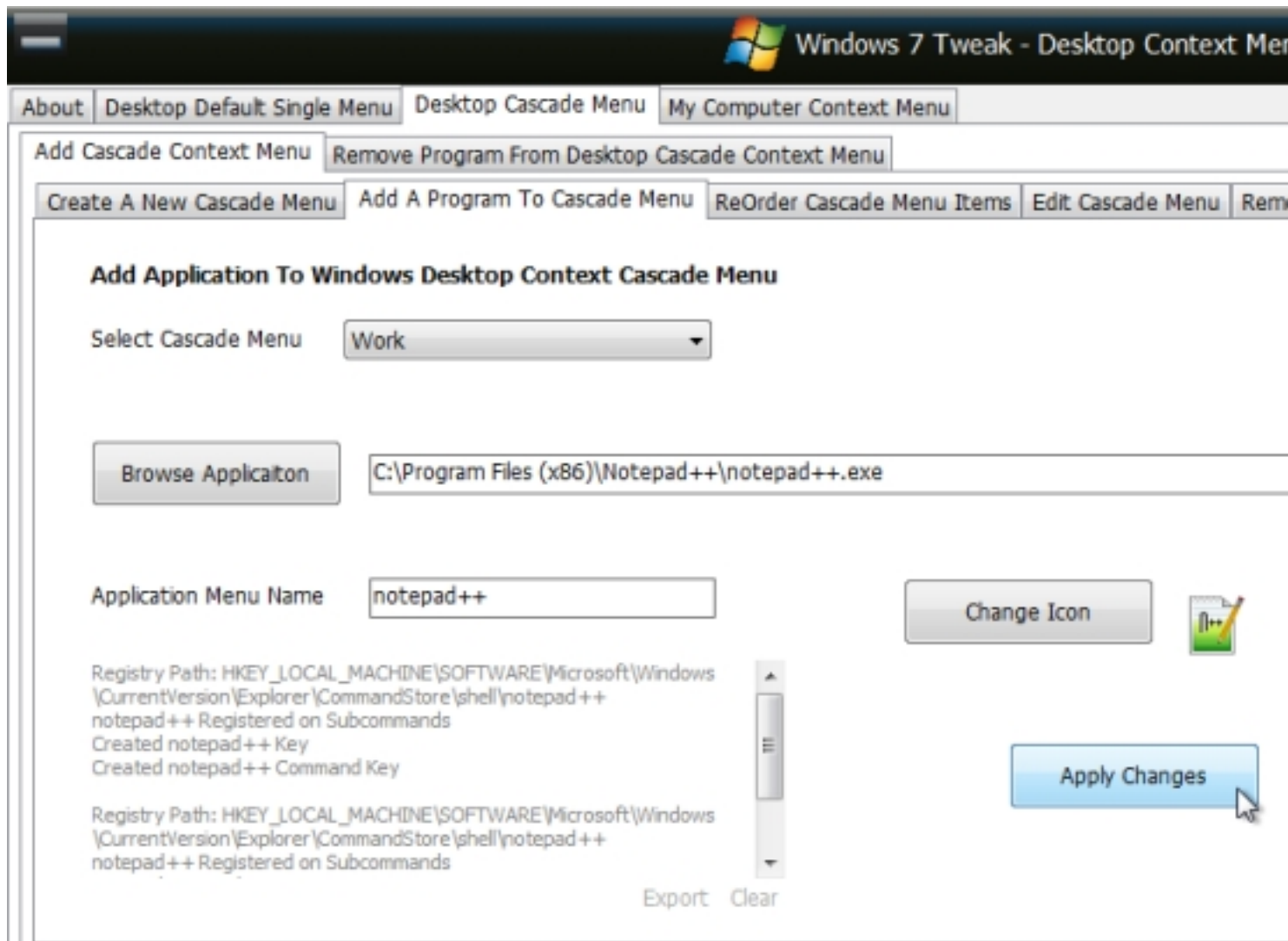

*Advanced*

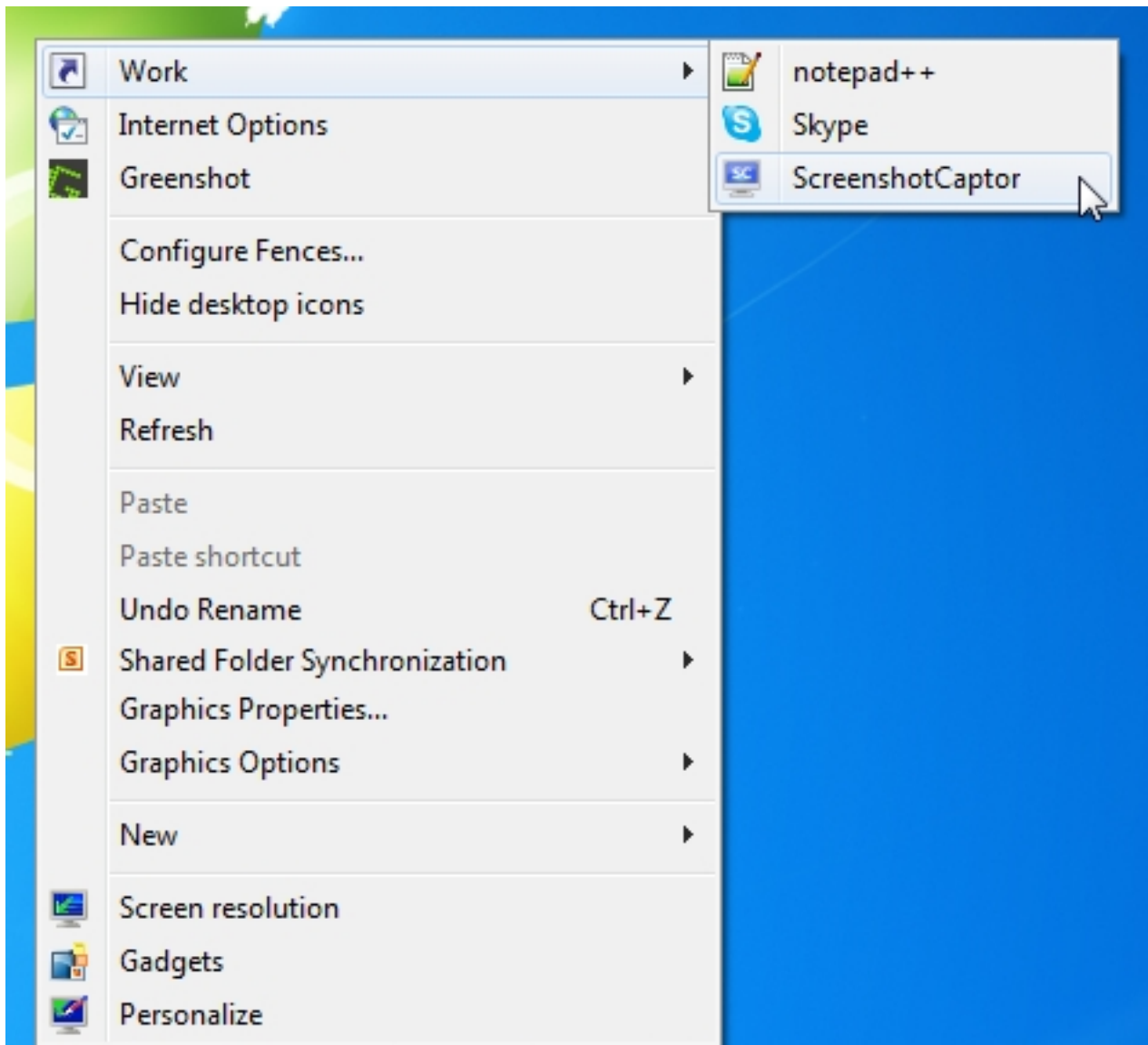
tab lets you add system locations like Internet Options, System Properties, User Accounts, Programs & Features, Task Manager etc., to context menu.
