

Sharing funny GIF animations has been a popular internet trend for over a decade now. Head over to most of the internet forums and websites, and you will see numerous

comic GIF animations shared by various people. If you have ever wanted to create your own animated GIF image files to publish them on forums, then give

### **openAviToGif**

a try. This open source program allows you to convert AVI videos into animated GIF sequences. The utility supports batch mode, allowing you to convert as many AVI files as you want in one go. You just need to grab both the application and the CODEC pack (which is also available on the developer's page) to create GIF animations from your video (AVI) files. Read on to find out how the program works.

When you have downloaded the program and the CODEC pack, just place all the files in a single folder, and run the application's executable file. To convert a file, just drag the AVI file over the application to add it to the list. You may drag & drop multiple files at once. Now, under the *Settings* section, specify your required settings for the output file, which includes *Output resolution*

(height & width)

, *Processed frame(s) at a time*, *Delay between frames* (in millisecond) and

*Max threads*

. Furthermore, you can enable

*Infinite loop*

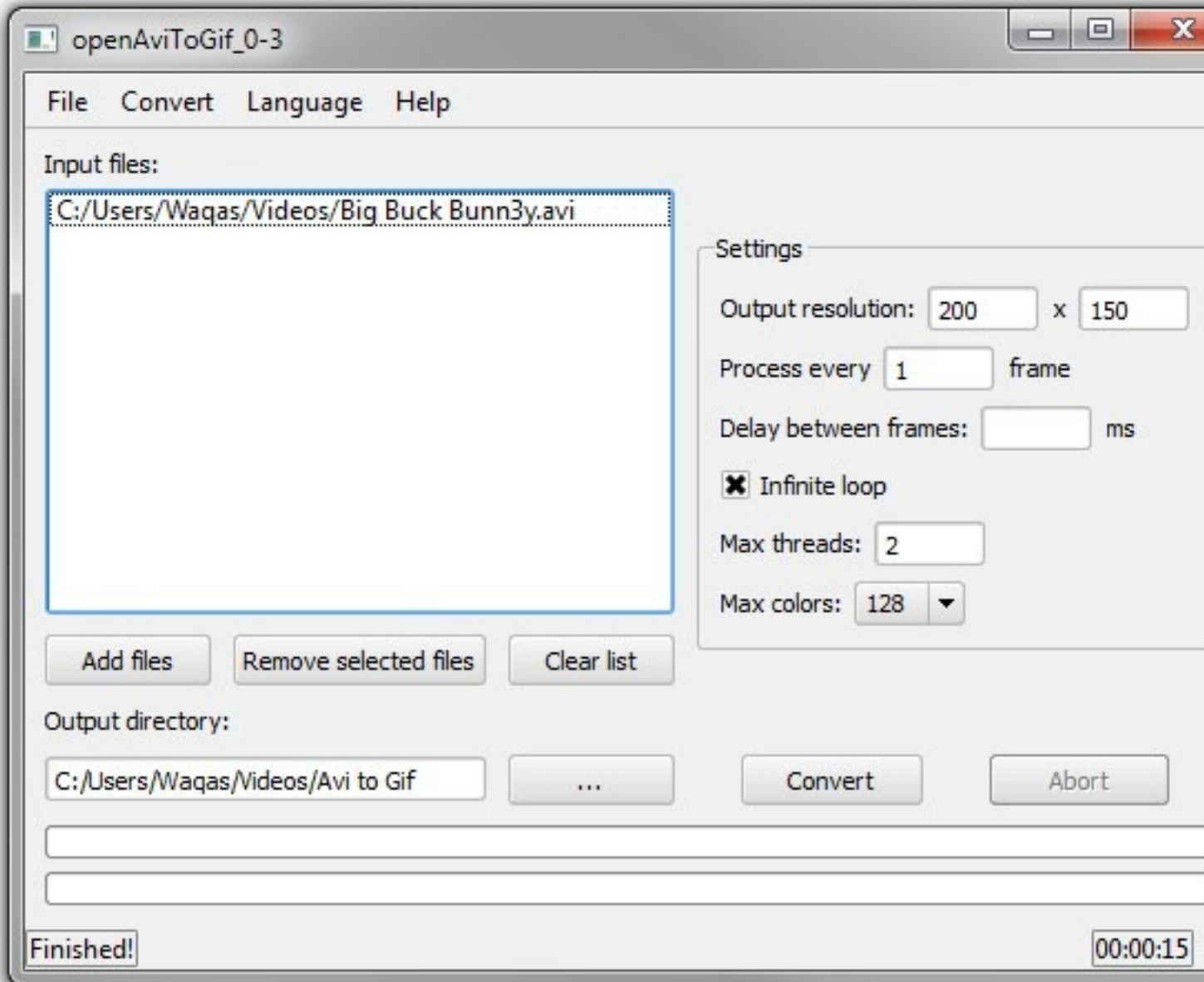
and specify

*Max*

colors (from 2 Bit to 256bit) to be used for animated GIF. Now, under

the *Output directory* section, choose your destination folder and click the *Convert*

button to start the conversion process.



Download openAviToGif for Windows, Mac, Linux, Android, iOS, and Raspberry Pi. Highly recommended for generating animated GIFs from AVI videos.
