

The iPad Notification Center hasn't been able to attract as many admirers as its iPhone counterpart. Many people have issues with the NC's size on the tablet's larger screen. Until recently, there were similar concerns about the size of notification banners on iPad, but NCPad for jailbroken iPad (reviewed [here](#)) resolved that problem by stretching notification banners to the width of the tablet's screen. **MountainLionCenter** does roughly the same thing for Notification Center on iPad. It optimizes the NC for your tablet, copying the notification management system billed to be used in Mac OS X Mountain Lion. This means that once you install this Cydia tweak on your jailbroken iPad, NC will appear on the right of your screen, spanning the whole height of the display, rather than the usual half.
