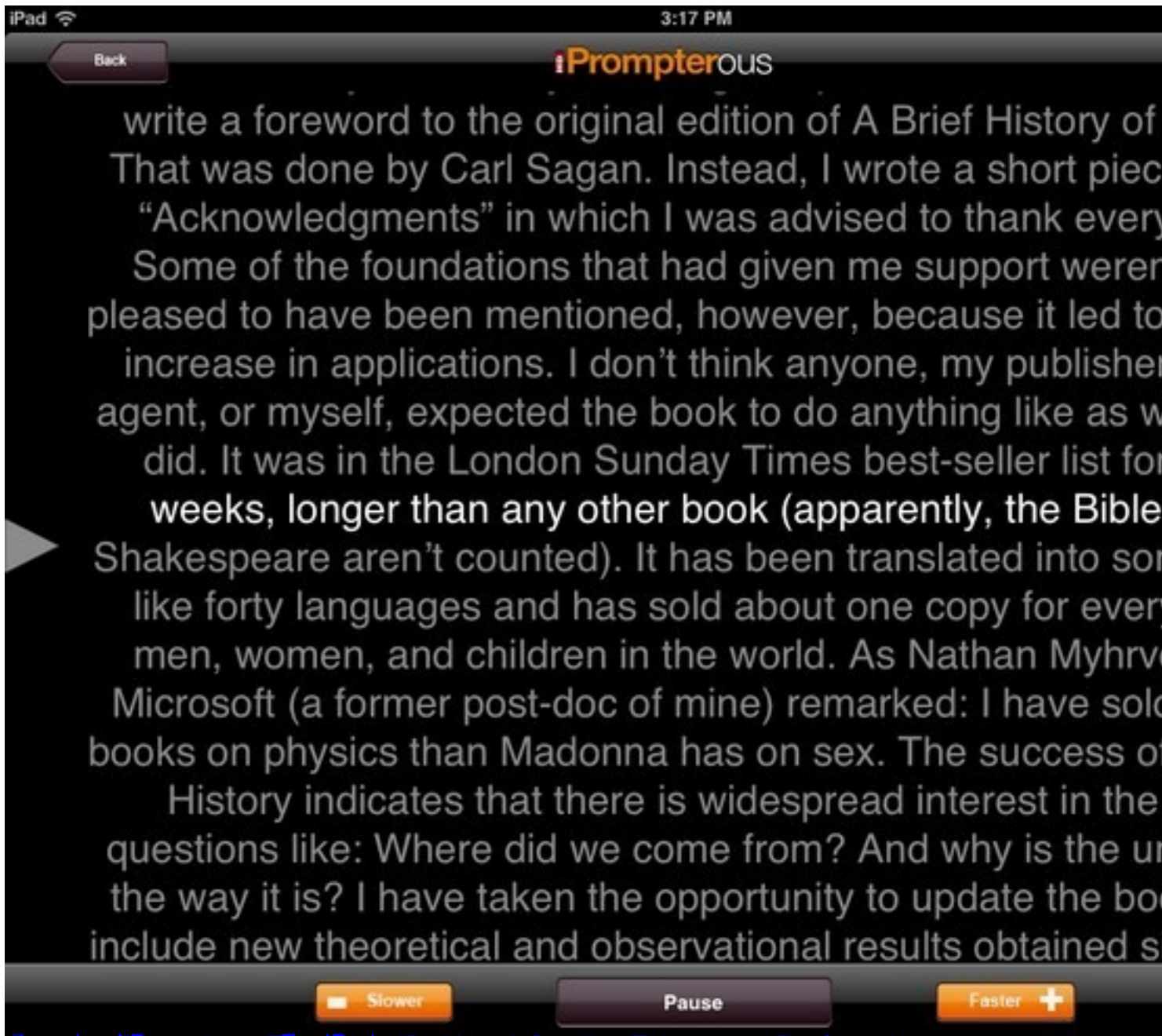

But like most other things, there's an app for that. **Prompterous** is an app converts your iPad into a teleprompter, lets you create new documents natively and import existing ones from the cloud or via email.
